PREGNANCY LOSS

Sadly pregnancy loss can affect up to 1 in 4 of pregnancies and fertility patients are acutely aware of every loss including very early losses of failed ICF cycles, or chemical pregnancies which do not develop.

Miscarriages at any stage of a pregnancy are heart breaking.

The impact is profound for anyone experiencing loss, however we recognise that for fertility patients who have often endured a long and harrowing fertility journey, the trauma and emotional consequences can often trigger isolation along with depression, or anxiety as well as PTSD. Sometimes joining a miscarriage support group elsewhere where members conceive naturally without assisted conception, can be hard to feel understood.

We hear you say that you want to be supported in a group of people who understand your loss and how this is compounded by the additional difficulties of a struggle to conceive and your fertility journey. As a result of your feedback, Fertility Network Scotland have created a Pregnancy Loss peer support group facilitated with a **BICA*** trained Volunteer Counsellor and now hold online monthly group meetings.

Together with our Support and Info Helpline and availability of additional wellbeing programmes of mindfulness and yoga, we aim to offer a wraparound support service to those that have experienced loss.

PREGNANCY LOSS GROUP

Our online group meetings are held on the last Thursday of the month at 7pm and are facilitated by Gemma Antcliffe, who is a trained **BICA** fertility counsellor.
